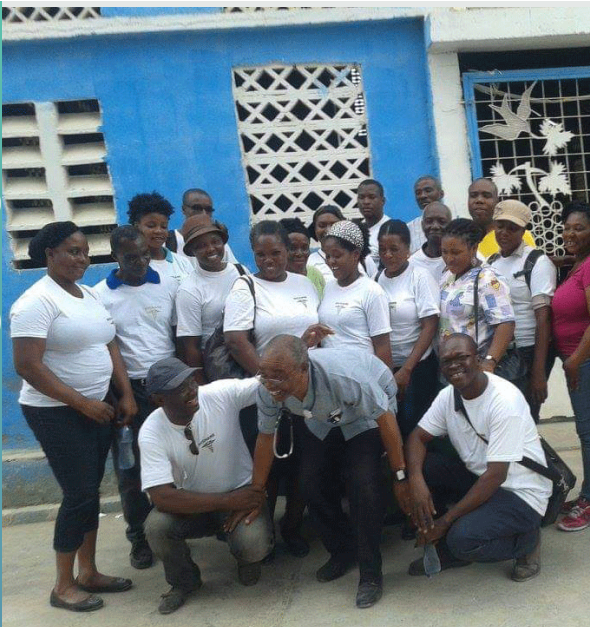


MICHANE

The Christian Ministry of Assistance to those in Needs (Ministère Chrétien d'Assistance aux Necessiteux – MICHANE) was launched in 2008 when we organized a food and supply distribution on January 1st and subsequently a mobile health clinic during easter season that same year.

MICHANE is a Florida nonprofit organization funded exclusively through member contribution. The establishment of this organization was in response to an observation that the elderly population had no support system in rural Haiti.

Through concrete actions, this ministry seeks to meet the basic health and nutritional needs of the elderly population through mobile clinics, preventative health measures, critical medical appointments, and food distribution.

OUR MISSION

The mission of MICHANE is to promote social action through meeting health and nutritional needs of the elderly population.

OUR ACTIVITIES

1

Mobile Clinics – Twice a year, we mobilize partners and health care professionals to host a free clinic to provide regular check ups and disease management services to the elderly.

2

Home Visits for Follow-ups – Health care professionals volunteers times and skills for follow up visits to monitor the health condition of our beneficiaries and make appropriate recommendations. Those visits are organized to ensure health care is being provided and that our beneficiaries have access to health care professionals and specialists required by their conditions.

Food Distribution – Twice a semester, we distribute food to those at risk of hunger in collaboration with churches and other faith-based organizations.

MICHANE focus on challenging all Christians to embrace their calling to bring good news to those in needs through a philanthropic culture.

MICHANE work to inspire churches and faith-based organizations to emphasize social intervention for support to those in needs. We do that through actions and conferences on Christian solidarity.

To that effect, we appoint church liaisons responsible to motivate local congregants to participate in social actions.

By so doing, we engage a change movement that set the tone to a philanthropic culture.
